<sup>1</sup> Secondary 1 students are nominated by class tutors to be junior prefects. Short-listed students are interviewed and selected by the Prefect Masters in consultation with the Prefects Ex-Co.

<sup>2</sup> Secondary 2 students may be recommended by teachers to be new junior prefects while existing junior prefects are reviewed and re-appointed by the Prefect Masters in consultation with the Prefects Ex-Co and teachers.

<sup>3</sup> Secondary 2 students are nominated by class tutors and CCA teachers to be PSLs. Short-listed students are interviewed and selected by the Lasallian Youth Formation Team teachers in charge of peer support training.

<sup>4</sup> Peer Support Leaders' Training Camp held in November.

<sup>5</sup> Secondary 3 students may be recommended by teachers to be new senior prefects while existing Secondary 2 junior prefects are reviewed and re-appointed as senior prefects by the Prefect Masters in consultation with the Prefects Ex-Co and teachers.

<sup>6</sup> All Secondary 3 class chairmen and students identified to hold key house and CCA appointments in Secondary 4 will attend the Lasallian Leadership Training Camp (LLTC). Other Secondary 3 students with leadership potential are nominated by class tutors and CCA teachers to attend LLTC. Short-listed students, based on class/CCA quota and ranking, are invited to attend the camp by the Lasallian Youth Formation Team and the Singapore Lasallian Youth Commission.

<sup>7</sup> The Lasallian Leadership Training Programme comprises the actual training camp (LLTC) in June or LLTC 'B' in October and the successful completion and submission of the Lasallian Award Journal.

<sup>8</sup> Secondary 3 students who were PSLs apply to be PSFs. Short-listed students are interviewed and selected by the Lasallian Youth Formation Team teachers in charge of peer support training.

<sup>9</sup> Secondary 3 students apply to be ACE leaders. Students are short-listed and selected by the PE Department teachers.

<sup>10</sup> Secondary 3 students who are interested apply to be Camp La Salle facilitators in March. Students are short-listed and selected by the Lasallian Youth Formation Team.

<sup>11</sup> Secondary 3 students who attended LLTC in June are invited to be LLTC 'B' facilitators in October. Students are short-listed and selected by the Lasallian Youth Formation Team.

<sup>12</sup> Head Prefect nominees are interviewed by PSJ and will also form the Prefects Ex-Co.

<sup>13</sup> Secondary 4 students who attended LLTC in Secondary 3 apply to be Camp La Salle facilitators in March. Students are short-listed and selected by the Lasallian Youth Formation Team.

<sup>14</sup> Secondary 4 students who attended LLTC in Secondary 3 apply to be LLTC facilitators in June. Students are short-listed based on application and teachers' recommendations and selected by the Lasallian Youth Formation Team.
